Collection of studies on fundamental problems of economic analysis, as well as on monetary economics. The book contains both new and already published material.

2008. *The Ethics of Money Production* (Auburn, Ala.: Mises Institute). xi + 280 pp.

A plea for monetary reform, this book highlights the role of money within the market economy and discusses the ethical problems of competitive money production. Its main focus is on the social, cultural, and spiritual consequences of government-sponsored inflation. It explains how such inflation vitiates the operation of national and international monetary systems and also causes numerous other problems such as the concentration of power and the decay of the family. Our present-day monetary system creates unjust incomes, destroys wealth, subverts the moral foundations of society, and ultimately paves the way for hyperinflation and totalitarianism.

I also show that this thesis is based on elementary propositions of monetary theory, in particular on the theory of the demand for money, and on the theory of economic calculation.

1993. *Kritik der Dominanztheorie*. [A Critique of F. Perroux's Theory of the Dominant Economy] (Frankfurt: R. G. Fischer). x + 153 pp.

According to François Perroux, the blind spot of conventional economic theory is power. Perroux claims that economics has to be supplemented by his theory of power, which will justify far-reaching political interventions in the market process. I show that conventional price theory *can* deal with the phenomenon of power and that Perroux's own theory is based on fallacy.
